


Lee needs your help to navigate her way to safety. Help her get to the Safe Meeting Place outside. Remember to get down low and go, go go!


# KITCHEN SAFETY

Careful or careless campers? In the picture below, circle all the ways these campers have been careful. Then put a big cross through all the ways they have been careless.


