












HOME FIRE ESCAPE PLAN










DIALLING TRIPLE ZERO (000)

Did you know that you can call Triple Zero (000) when a phone is locked. Look for the word 'emergency' or 'emergency call' on the screen. By pressing the emergency button, you can call Triple Zero (000).

- Colour in the phone and phone cover.
- 2. Glue to a piece of thin board.
- 3. When the glue is dry, cut out the phone.
- 4. Fold the board along the dotted lines.
- 5. Carefully place glue on the tabs, as shown.
- 6. Fold the back so it is secured to the glue tabs.
- 7. Leave it to dry.





Cut out the three ways to extinguish a fire, then on the next page position them so that they extinguish the fire.








